

Middle Township Fire District #2

May 15, 2014

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Sal DeSimone. Mr. DeSimone stated that notice had been given to the Herald Newspapers, the official paper and is posted on the bulletin board of the Middle Township Municipal Hall as required by P.L. 1975, c231, the Sunshine Law.

Roll call was taken with commissioners Sal DeSimone, Conrad Johnson, Kirby Stiltner, Robert Zimmerman and Jean Zimmerman present. Mr. Thomas Phelan, Attorney, Rich Sweeten and Bob Sweeten, were also present. Rodney Haines, Accountant, was absent.

COMMUNICATIONS: letter received from Middle Township regarding using the fire hall for elections for districts 12, 13 and 14. Sal suggested giving the letter to the Rio Grande Fire Company and also thought there should be a written agreement if decided to accept their request. Motion Kirby Stiltner, second Conrad Johnson to give letter to the fire company.

Financial Statements received from Rodney Haines which included a group affidavit, resolution and synopsis to be published in the Cape May County Herald newspapers. Fire Chief Rich Sweeten said he would see if Ray Brown could do an appraisal for the fire company.

OLD BUSINESS: the injured fireman who was asking for his life member status hasn't been seen nor heard from to be given his options.

NEW BUSINESS: LOSAP 2013: 22 qualified with the possibility of 1 or 2 more according to Bob Sweeten. At \$1100 per person the cost for 22 people will be \$24,200 or \$26,400 if the other two qualify. As soon as confirmed the list will be posted for 30 days on the bulletin board. Bob Sweeten said he would like to make the payment in June.

CHIEF'S REPORT: 103 fire calls; structure fire on Indian Trail was due to a dehumidifier; more old cop cars to be used for next jaws drill; drill at Pier 47 to preplan any water problems; the new Durango is going to be lettered

TREASURER'S REPORT: Sal DeSimone read the bills, motion by resolution to pay the bills by Robert Zimmerman second Conrad Johnson, of \$14,557.62. Motion carried.
