

MIDDLE TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT #2

August 16, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Salvatore DeSimone. Mr. DeSimone stated that notice had been given to the Herald Newspapers, the official paper and is posted on the bulletin board of the Middle Township Municipal Hall as required by P.L. 1975, c231, the Sunshine Law.

Roll call was taken with commissioners, Salvatore DeSimone, Conrad Johnson, Kirby Stiltner, Robert Zimmerman and Jean Zimmerman present. Attorney Mr. Thomas Phelan, Robert Sweeten, Kirby Stiltner Jr. and Rio Grande Fire Company Chief Richard Sweeten were also present. Rodney Haines, Accountant, was absent.

COMMUNICATIONS: None at this time

OLD BUSINESS: Robert Zimmerman said the solar panels are almost finished. He will be receiving a call in a couple of days to say the power will be turned off for a couple of hours while they switch over.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Phelan stated that the Fire Bureau v. Joe Pinto (produce stand next to Westside Market) is in Superior Court for collections of \$100,000

Bob Sweeten talked with Mike McLaughlin about Kyle Lindholm's request to attend fire calls if he was available. Mike said the firehouse could make him a temporary firefighter.

Quote for 2017 Chevy Tahoe that was in accident is \$2,508.85 from Eddie's Auto said Bob Sweeten. He will get a second quote.

Bob Sweeten asked about increasing the \$1,100 LOSAP contribution. He will check with other fire districts about their contribution amounts.

CHIEF'S REPORT: 210 fire calls; quotes received for potential vehicles from a state contractor for base vehicles with no lighting and at 2018 prices were \$27,950 for Explorer Interceptor, \$39,300 for Expedition and \$28,724 for F-150; on Saturday Amkus will be doing a jaws demonstration; Walmart construction caused the store to fill with carbon monoxide; yearly physicals were given with couple minor issues that are being taken care of

TREASURER'S REPORT: Salvatore De Simone read the bills, motion by resolution to pay the bills by Kirby Stiltner second Bob Zimmerman, of \$11,029.35 Motion carried.
