

Middle Township Fire District #2

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Sal DeSimone. Mr. DeSimone stated that notice had been given to the Herald Newspapers, the official paper and is posted on the bulletin board of the Middle Township Municipal Hall as required by P.L. 1975, c231, the Sunshine Law.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

COMMUNICATIONS: letter from the Middle Township Tax Assessor

OLD BUSINESS: none at this time

NEW BUSINESS: Rodney Haines reviewed the 2013 Budget and said he was able to keep the amount of taxes to be raised the same as last year at \$536,800. Motion Kirby Stiltner, second Conrad Johnson to accept the budget as introduced approved

Motion Conrad Johnson, second Kirby Stiltner to move up to \$200,000 to a reserve CD

Elections will be held February 16, 2013. Sal DeSimone and Jean Zimmerman are up for re-election. Petitions are due by January 17th, 2013

CHIEF'S REPORT: 214 fire calls; spent 4 days in Beach Haven helping after Superstorm Sandy; will receive approximately \$2200 from FEMA; have to file NFIRS report for each day spent in Beach Haven; was at a chimney fire that had a wood burning fireplace that was improperly lined

TREASURER'S REPORT: Sal DeSimone read the bills, motion by resolution to pay the bills by Robert Zimmerman second Kirby Stiltner, of \$5,630.36. Motion carried.
